

RULES AND REGULATIONS

I- GENERAL TERMS

1° Admission terms

The manager or his representative must allow you to enter, settle and stay in the campsite. He must make sure that the campsite is well-kept and well-maintained and that the present rules are respected.

If you stay in "LES AMARINES II" campsite, you must agree to the present rules and promise to comply with them.

2° Police formalities

Any person who is to stay at least one night in the campsite must show his/her identity papers to the manager and fill in the formalities required by the police. People under 18 without their parents are allowed only with a permission written by their parents.

3° Settlement

The tent or the caravan and the equipment related to them must be put up on the pitch specified by the manager.

4° Reception

Open from **8.00 A.M to 8.00 P.M.**

At the reception you'll find all the information about the services of the campsite, information about supplying, sports facilities, tourist richness of the region and various useful addresses.

5° Charges

The charges are paid at the reception. Their amount is posted at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception. You are charged according to the number of nights spent in the campsite. The campers must inform the reception when they leave the day before. The campers who want to leave before the opening time of the reception must pay their charges the day before.

6° Noise and silence

We expressly advise campers to avoid any noise or talk which can disturb their neighbours. Appliances must be adjusted accordingly. You must be as silent as possible when you close doors and boots. Dogs and other pets mustn't be free. They mustn't be left alone in the campsite when their owners are away, even shut in. Owners are legally responsible for them. Total silence is required between **11.00P.M and 7.00 A.M.**

7° Guests

Once allowed by the manager the guests can enter the campsite under the supervision of the campers who accommodate them. The cars of the guests are forbidden in the campsite.

8° Traffic and parking of vehicles

Within the campsite, vehicles mustn't exceed **10 Km/h** and must be parked on the space that was planned when booking.

Only the vehicles belonging to the campers can go in the campsite. Parking is strictly forbidden on the pitches and you can't neither hold up traffic nor prevent new comers from settling.

9° Maintenance and appearance of facilities

Everyone must turn one's attention to cleanliness, hygiene and to the state of the campsite. It is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in the gutter. People in caravans must throw their waste water in the appropriate facilities. The household refuse, any waste, papers must be dumped in the dustbins. Everyone must turn one's attention to cleanliness, hygiene and to the state of the campsite and its facilities especially the toilet blocks. You must do your washing in the appropriate

tubs. Plantations and flower beds must be respected. Campers mustn't drive nails in trees, cut branches, plant. They mustn't delineate the pitch with their own equipments, dig a hole in the ground. The perpetrator of any damage caused to the vegetation, the fences, the site or the facilities will be charged. The camper should keep the pitch he/she stays on in the same condition as when he/she arrived.

10° Security

a) Fire

Stoves must be in good working order and must be used in safe conditions. In the event of a fire give notice forthwith to the management. Fire extinguishers can be used if necessary. There is a first aid kit at the reception. Open fire (charcoal) is strictly forbidden.

b) Theft

The management is responsible for the items left at the reception and must generally keep the campsite under surveillance. The camper is responsible for his/her own equipment and must point out any suspicious-looking person to the manager. Although security is assured, we ask campers to take usual precautions watching over their equipment.

11° Games

Violent or annoying games can't be organized near the facilities. Parents should always keep an eye on their children.

12° Vehicle storage

Non-occupied equipment can be left on the pitch once the management agrees and only on the specified plot. The vehicle storage will be charged according to the amount posted at the reception.

13° Posting

The present rules and regulations are posted at the reception and at the entrance of the campsite. The client can get them on request.

14° Transgression against rules

If a resident disturbs other campers during their stay or doesn't respect the clauses of the present rules and regulations, if necessary the manager can tell or write the latter to require him/her to stop disturbing the peace. In the event of serious or oft-repeated transgression against the present rules and once the manager is required to comply with them, the agreement can be terminated. In the event of criminal offence the manager can call the police.
